TUCKER BRYANT is an award-winning poet and Stanford graduate who left a role in Product Marketing at Google to help businesses grow through his work. DR. KIMBERLY FRAZIER serves as the 71st president of the American Counseling Association. Dr. Frazier received her PhD in Counselor Education from the University of New Orleans. Her research areas of interest include the impact of systemic oppression and trauma on marginalized people of color. Dr. Frazier is an expert on best practices applying cultural competency in the workplace,

leadership, advocacy and working with children and families of color. Many of her published works can be found in the Journal of Multicultural Counseling and Development and the Journal of Counseling and Professional Psychology.

BAND is a trauma-informed licensed mental health therapist focusing on strategy and application for integrating Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging within mental health care practice/public education/policy. She promotes culturally responsive practices by deconstructing theory and research to create a more accessible understanding of mental health concepts for all. Dr. Band serves as an SME for

nonprofits such as The AAKOMA Project, whose mission focuses on the mental health for youth of color and the JED Foundation, whose mission is to protect the emotional health of adolescents and prevent suicide in the U.S. She regularly contributes to news and media in places such as Counseling Today, ABC News 7, ASIAN Project, Forbes Health, and Reuters.
