- 9. Journal statistics for the prior 12-month period:
 - 135 manuscripts received; 67 manuscripts rejected without review (inappropriate); accept ratio = 23.8%
 - average time to assign reviewer = 1.8 days; average reviewer turnaround time = 27.2 days
- average time from submission to first decision = 16.6 days; average time from submission to final decision = 25.9 days
 10. Impact Factor = .93 (2-year), 1.6 (5-year).
- 11. Full text downloads via Wiley Online Library increased by 10%, from 37,960 in 2016 to 41,580 in 2017.
- 12. CDQ ranks 46 of 82 applied psychology journals worldwide (from most current data, 2017)
- 13. Presented program on publishing at 2019 NCDA annual meeting
